

Information regarding Churches - COVID-19

Under the present Covid-19 restrictions in Newfoundland and Labrador, the Parish will now return to the regular four masses per weekend schedule.

The schedule is as follows:

- 4:00 p.m. Saturday, St. Anne's Church, Dunville
- 6:00 p.m., Saturday, Sacred Heart Church, Placentia
- 9:30 a.m., Sunday, Holy Rosary Church, Freshwater
- 11:15 a.m., Sunday, Alternating between Sacred Heart Church, Fox Harbour and St. Theresa's Church, Ship Harbour

The following guidelines will apply for each Mass: Effective February 28

- Maximum capacity of 50% of church building capacity
- Pre-registration is recommended (see below).
- Doors will open 30 minutes before each mass time.
- Those attending Mass will be required to:
 - Appropriately answer all Covid-19 screening questions
 - Provide information for contact tracing
 - Sanitize hands upon entry and other times as directed
 - Set in a designated pews
 - Always wear a mask
 - Follow directions of COVID team members

Parishioners are asked to respect and follow the direction of volunteer greeters and ushers while in the church. These volunteers will be assisting with seating, communion and exiting. This will ensure adherence to required guidelines.
