Letter that was sent to Priests and Parish Finance Committee Chairpersons this week by Archbishop Peter Hundt:

Re: Parish Properties

As you are aware, the sale by tender process with respect to a large number of St. John's parish properties is coming to a conclusion. The Court appointed Monitor will soon be filing his report with respect to this tender sales process, recommending that approximately 40 properties be sold (some to parishioner groups but many to organizations not affiliated with the church).

With the coming conclusion of this sale by tender process, the liquidation process in support of Victim claims will now be focusing on the properties outside of St. John's.

A decision has been made in consultation with the Monitor (who in turn consulted with Representative Counsel) to engage the services of multiple qualified real estate agents to list RCECSJ properties situated in the Burin and Southern Avalon regions for sale (and also the St. John's properties of the tender process that were not sold). The Monitor has been in contact with various local real estate agents to prepare for this exercise. The agents will most likely require access to our properties prior to finalizing the listings and placing the properties onto the market.
