Information regarding Churches - COVID-19

Churches in our Parish have reopened under the guidelines for COVID-19 Alert 2.

Guidelines include:

- Maximum of 100 people.
- Face masks must be worn by congregants throughout (except when receiving Communion, and lectors, cantors, and the celebrant when ministering).
- The need to observe social distancing and enhanced sanitation protocols.
- Contact tracing Registration

Doors will open 30 minutes before mass time. Upon arrival parishioners will confirm their pre-registration with the greeter and will be asked to read and confirm compliance with the COVID-19 Self Assessment Screening Questionnaire, which will be displayed at the entrance to the church. Parishioners are reminded that if they are feeling ill, they should not attend public worship.

Parishioners are asked to respect and follow the direction of volunteer greeters and ushers while in the church. These volunteers will be assisting with seating, communion and exiting. This will ensure adherence to required guidelines.

Each church will have a different capacity based on size and layout. Pre-registration to attend mass will be required. To register to attend mass you are asked to contact **weekly** the designated volunteer for your church between **10:00 am and 2:00 pm on Wednesday**. <u>Skills Transition Program scheduled for September 7 – December 22, 2021 at College of the North</u> Atlantic, Placentia Campus

The Skills Transition Program consists of **12 weeks of paid classroom training** and **4 weeks of paid on-the-job training**. In addition, all materials, supplies, workbooks and textbooks are provided, including Personal Protective Equipment. Students are also eligible for a completion bonus of \$650.

Entrance Requirements:

Students must be:

- o between the ages of 19 and 29 (inclusive) at the time of intake/selection;
- high school non-graduates
- Minimum of Grade 9 education
- not in employment
- o not in training at time of enrollment
- Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or persons who have been granted refugee status in
- o **Canada**
- legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations:
- Participants in receipt of Employment Insurance (EI) benefits are eligible. For participants in receipt of EI they must first consult with their Service Canada office before participating.

Registration deadline is August 6, 2021.
