The third **World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly** will be celebrated this year on **Sunday, 23 July 2023**. Pope Francis inaugurated this World Day to be celebrated by the universal Church each July, either on or near the liturgical Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, grandparents of Jesus, to help "treasure the spiritual and human wealth that has been handed down from generation to generation". Pope Francis' chosen theme for this year's World Day is "***His mercy is from age to age***" (Lk 1:50), raising the relational interconnection between the old and the young. The theme is especially fitting in light of the upcoming World Youth Day (WYD) in Lisbon, which will take place from 1-6 August 2023. To showcase this theme, the **CCCB Standing Committee for Family and Life, in tandem with its Office**, produced a [30 second video](#) which captures a group of high school students visiting the elderly at a retirement home. The heartwarming interaction of old and young wonderfully represents this year's World Day theme and inspires us to find concrete and creative ways to draw near to the elderly. Sacred Heart Church, Placentia

Questions regarding whether Sacred Heart Church could be used in case of inclement weather for the Cemetery Mass and Final Mass?

- Because of the water damage and the risk of molds, which could affect any respiratory infection or one’s physical health, “it seems unsafe and imprudent to plan any event to take place”. (Archbishop Hundt)

Why does it take so long to address this issue?

- As Sacred Heart Church remains RCECSJ property and is therefore subject to the CCAA process, all expenditures must be approved by the court appointed Monitor.

Will there be a Final Mass at Sacred Heart Church, Placentia?

- Yes, once it's safe to do so.
