Update from the Archbishop regarding the June 2nd Sale of Archdiocesan Properties

On June 2, 2022, the tender process closed for the sale of a number of church properties in the greater St. John's area. This process was independently administered by the Court appointed Monitor. We have been advised that the Monitor is reviewing bids and consulting with stakeholders. In the coming weeks the Monitor will provide responses regarding the recommended acceptance or rejection of individual bids. The Monitor will then submit a report inclusive of recommendations of bids for the Court to approve. As we receive further information regarding the results of this sales process, we will begin working with parish priests and parish representatives in determining and implementing the pastoral and administrative changes resulting from these sales.

Please join with me in praying for wisdom and understanding as we continue this restructuring process.
