There will also be a celebration in his hometown of Fox Harbour

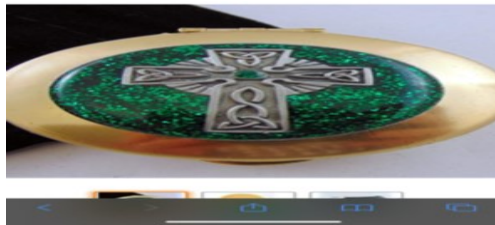
on Wednesday, June 29th (Anniversary date)

Thanks to all who contributed to the Synodality Report of the Archdiocese of St. John’s

The first phase in of the 2023 Synod on Synodality has now been completed in the Archdiocese of St. John’s. Our Archdiocesan report has been sent to the Atlantic Episcopal Assembly where an Atlantic Regional Report will be prepared.

The Archdiocesan Local Listening Process was overseen and facilitated by the Redemptorist Adult Faith Formation Team (RAFFT). Thirteen focus groups gathered in different parts of the Archdiocese, either in person or online. In each focus group, discussion and conversation revolved around the ten themes in the preparatory document. People also had the opportunity to respond to the ten themes by means of an online survey. Thirty responses were received, each of them commenting on all ten themes.

Our thanks goes out to RAFFT and to all the individuals and groups whose involvement and input have contributed to the participation of the Archdiocese of St. John’s in this first phase of the 2023 Synod on Synodality.
