### Information regarding Churches - COVID-19

# The Archdiocesan COVID-19 Sub-Committee Update of October 18, 2021:

The Archdiocese of St. John's **will not** require people to verify proof of vaccination using the vaccine passport for worship services. Therefore, in accordance with public health measures as outlined at <a href="https://www.gov.nl.ca/covid-19/life-during-covid-19/vaccination-record/businesses-and-organizations/">https://www.gov.nl.ca/covid-19/life-during-covid-19/vaccination-record/businesses-and-organizations/</a> the following will apply to all Churches of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of St. John's:

- \*Everyone must wear a non-medical mask at all times (including the officiant and musicians);
- Congregational singing is not permitted;
- The names and contact information of all attendees must be recorded and retained for 14 days for contact tracing, and must be shared with public health officials if requested;
- Physical distancing must be maintained between individuals from different family groups; and,
- Entry must be restricted to only those who do not have COVID-19 symptoms and who are not required to self-isolate for any reason.

### **Points of Further Clarification:**

\*RE. the presider/musician wearing a face mask; the Sub-committee sought clarification from the government and was informed that the presider and cantor can remove their masks when speaking/singing

**IF:** - they are a minimum of 6ft/2m away from other people,

- they are the sole person using a given microphone

(i.e. these are practises already in use in our diocese and also apply to the lectors)

All other musicians and choir members must remain masked.

Contact tracing will again be mandatory which means names and phone numbers of those attending worship services must be recorded and the record kept for 14 days.

Parishioners are asked to respect and follow the direction of volunteer greeters and ushers while in the church. These volunteers will be assisting with seating, communion and exiting. This will ensure adherence to required guidelines.

### CCCB Pastoral Letter on Human Trafficking

The CCCB Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace has authored a pastoral letter on human trafficking entitled: For Freedom Christ has Set us Free: Pastoral Letter on Human Trafficking and Sexual Exploitation in Canada. This pastoral letter draws attention to the inherently exploitative and abusive nature of the purchase of sex and insists that in order to protect the vulnerable, this practice must continue to be criminalized: "Treating sex as 'work' masks the physical, psychological and sexual violence inflicted on the prostituted person. Prostitution involves selling something that by its nature cannot be bought or sold and is therefore inherently exploitative." This letter is likewise the fruit of the Commission's ongoing monitoring of the issue of human trafficking in Canada and abroad, and the participation over the years of its Chairmen in various international meetings, including those of the Santa Marta Group in Rome.
