Remembrance Day – November 11, 2020: This year the Annual Remembrance Day Ceremony at the Cenotaph in Placentia will be a private ceremony. This will enable the important observance to take place in compliance with Public Health Guidelines during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Any Veteran or Legion member wishing to attend the ceremony in person is asked to contact the Sergeant-at-Arms to register. Please contact Wayne Power at 227-4913 by Sunday, November 8, 2020. Individuals, families, or others wishing to place a wreath at the cenotaph in memory of a fallen comrade are invited and encouraged to do so privately following the 11:00 am ceremony. Following the ceremony, a Memorial Cross will be set up at the Cenotaph site. This will allow for the ritual where members of the public are invited to place their Poppies on the Memorial Cross in tribute to the fallen. The cross will remain in place until sunset on Remembrance Day. Lest We Forget!

Information regarding Churches - COVID-19

- Masks will need to be worn by everyone entering and moving around in our churches, although while in “physically distanced seating” masks may be removed (this also applies to the celebrant at the altar, the reader at the ambo and the cantor at the podium).

Doors will open 30 minutes before mass time. Upon arrival parishioners will confirm their pre-registration with the greeter and will be asked to read and confirm compliance with the COVID-19 Self Assessment Screening Questionnaire, which will be displayed at the entrance to the church. Parishioners are reminded that if they are feeling ill, they should not attend public worship.

Parishioners are asked to respect and follow the direction of volunteer greeters and ushers while in the church. These volunteers will be assisting with seating, communion and exiting. This will ensure adherence to required guidelines.

Each church will have a different capacity based on size and layout. Pre-registration to attend mass will be required. To register to attend mass you are asked to contact **weekly** the designated volunteer for your church between **10:00 am and 2:00 pm on Wednesday**. Please respect this process and only call at the indicated times. ***When you register, please identify if you are in a bubble with someone to help maximize seating capacity.***
