**Information regarding Churches - COVID-19**

The Archdiocesan COVID-19 Sub-Committee makes the following recommendations:

- Face Masks must be worn by congregants throughout (except when receiving Communion, and lectors, cantors, and the celebrant when ministering.
- The need to observe social distancing and enhanced sanitation protocols must be maintained.
- Contact tracing Registration

Doors will open 30 minutes before mass time. Upon arrival parishioners will confirm their pre-registration with the greeter and will be asked to read and confirm compliance with the COVID-19 Self Assessment Screening Questionnaire, which will be displayed at the entrance to the church. Parishioners are reminded that if they are feeling ill, they should not attend public worship.

Parishioners are asked to respect and follow the direction of volunteer greeters and ushers while in the church. These volunteers will be assisting with seating, communion and exiting. This will ensure adherence to required guidelines.

Each church will have a different capacity based on size and layout. Pre-registration to attend mass will be required. To register to attend mass you are asked to contact **weekly** the designated volunteer for your church between **10:00 am and 2:00 pm on Wednesday**.
